- Strengthen and develop **local self sustaining structures and linkages** related to equine welfare services and resources to benefit 100,000 working equine animals by 2014.

- Amplify and diversify the scope, scale and sustainability of existing work by developing substantial **partnership and advocacy initiatives** at local and national level
- Brooke's **research is used and applied** to strengthen the country programme
- **Strengthen Brooke Pakistan capabilities and systems** to achieve the five year strategy and contribute to the wider Brooke

# Principles of Animal Welfare

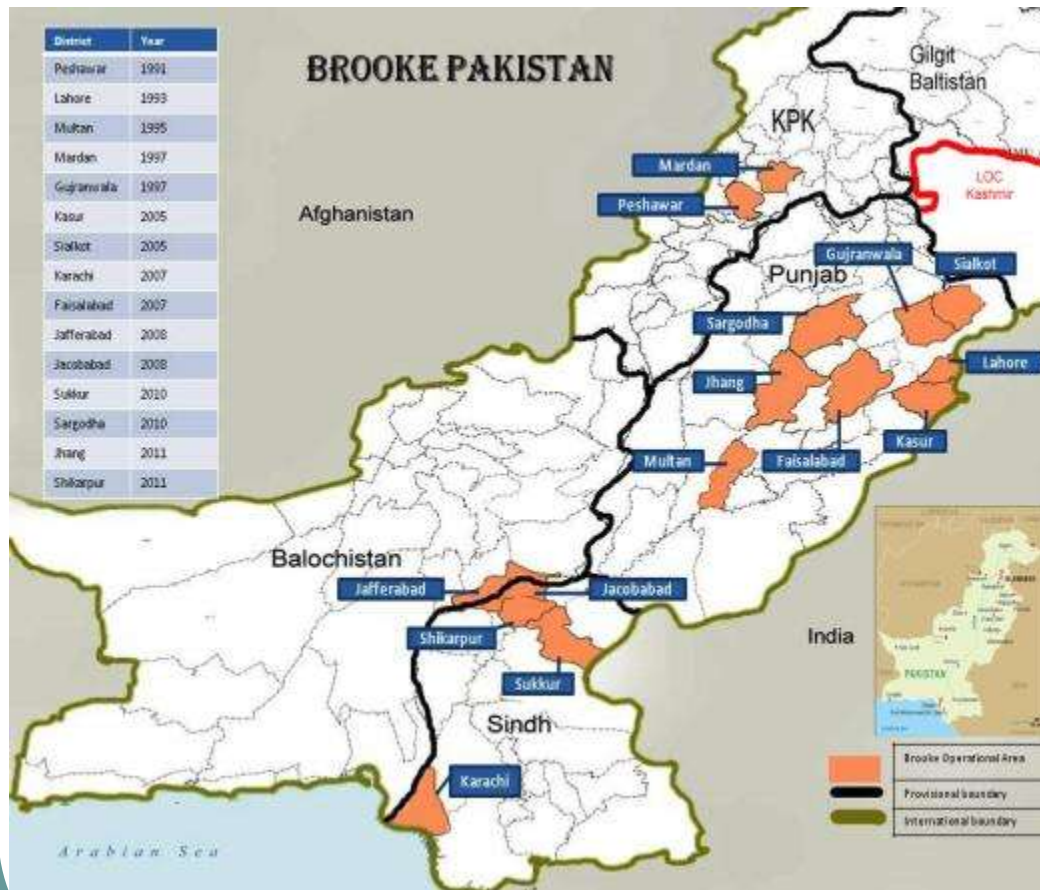
Five freedoms;

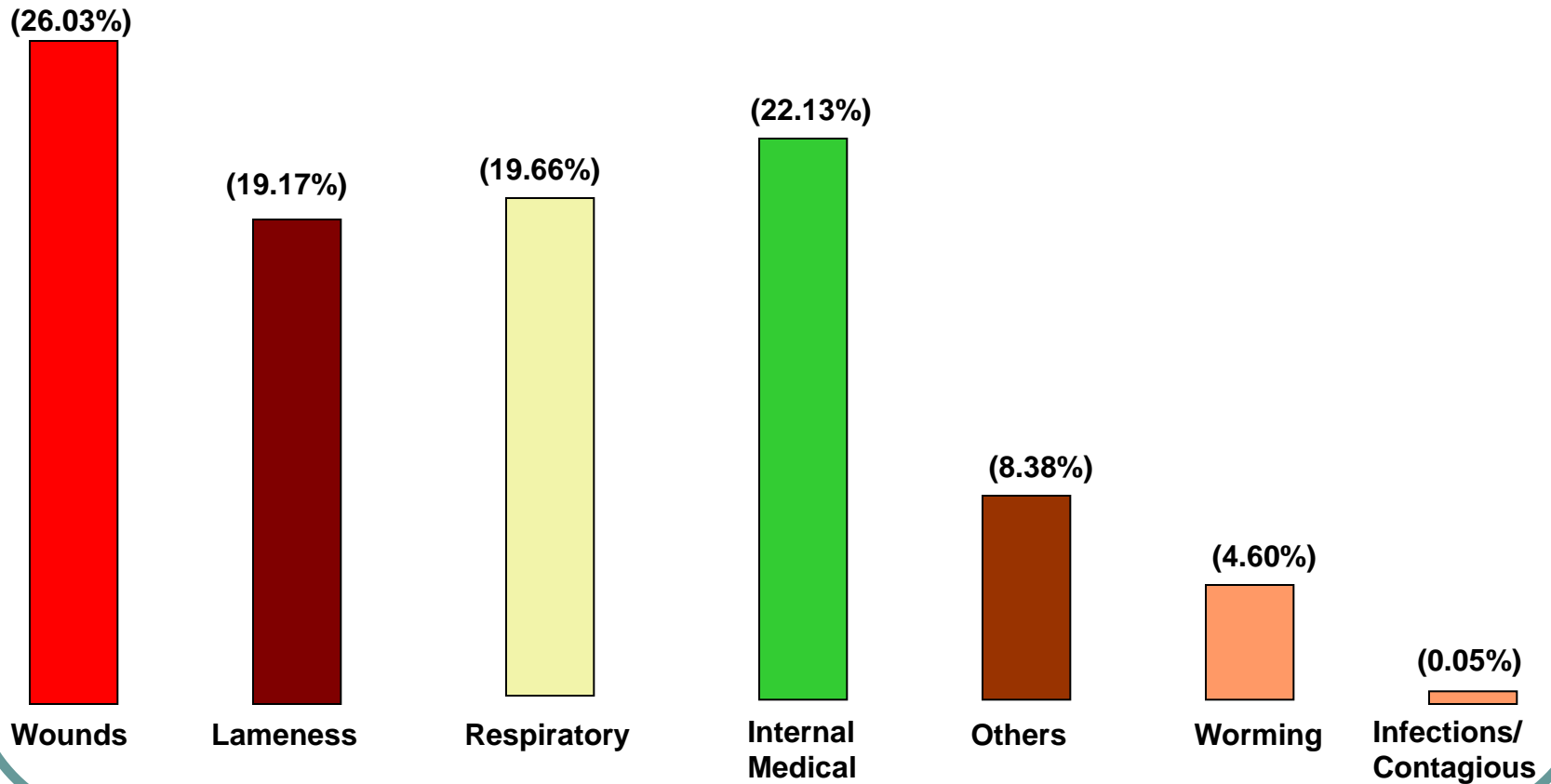

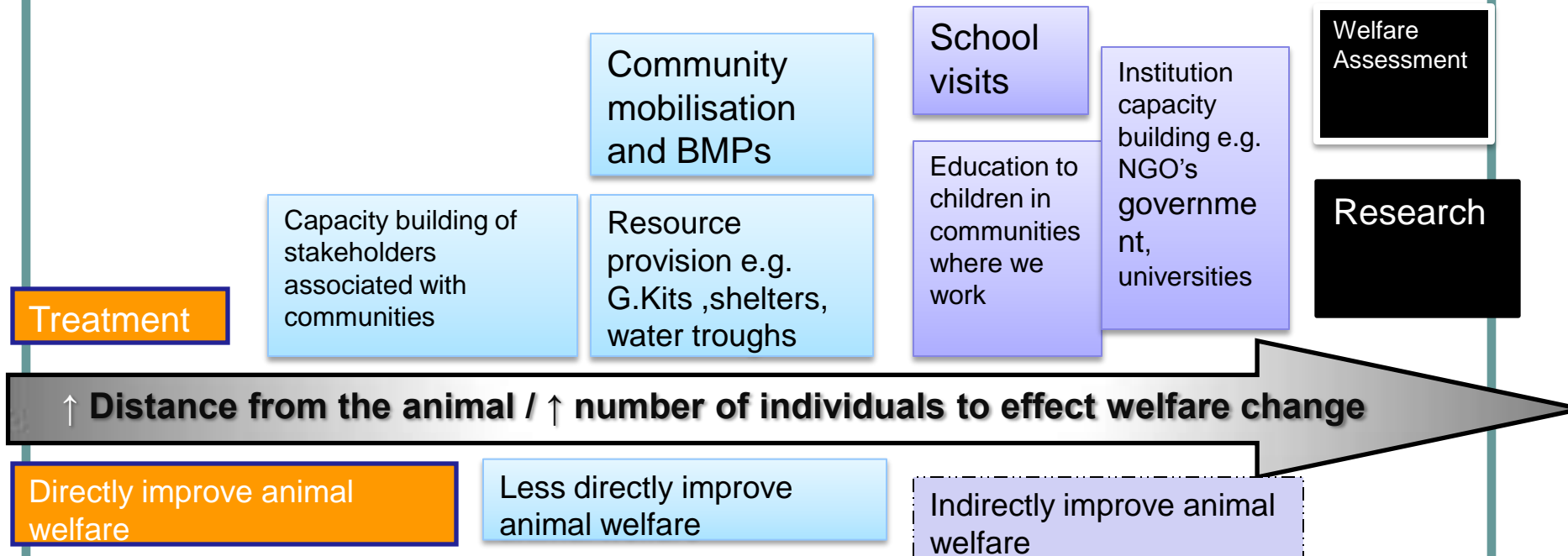


Diagram identifying 9 broad activities which Brooke Pakistan carries out with the aim of improving the welfare of working equines

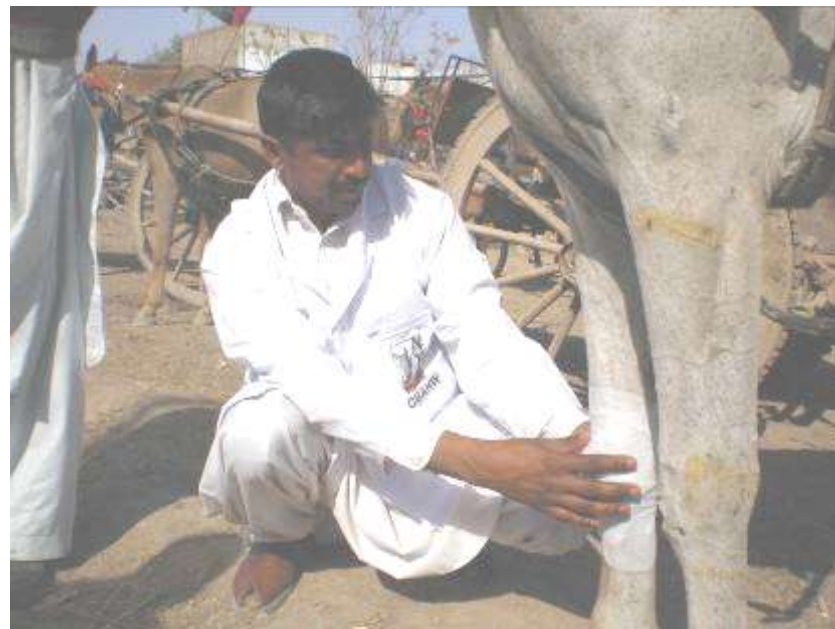
